From the South (via M1)

Leave the M1 at junction 38 and join the A637 towards Huddersfield. Continue through the village of West Bretton for approx. 2 miles. At the roundabout, turn left onto the A636 (Denby Dale Road). Continue for 0.5 miles and turn right onto Woodhouse Lane, towards Emley. Continue for approx. 3 miles through Emley and passing Emley Moor TV mast on the left. Turn right onto Jagger Lane and follow signs to Kirkburton after passing the mast. Follow the road (Turnshaw Road) downhill for 1.5 miles into Kirkburton. Turn right at the T-junction in the village onto North Road (B6116). Turn left into our car park after the pedestrian crossing.

From the North (via M1)

Leave the M1 at junction 39 and take the third exit onto the A636 (Denby Dale Road). Continue for approx. 3 miles to a roundabout, and take the 2nd exit, remaining on the A636. Continue for 0.5 miles and turn right onto Woodhouse Lane, towards Emley. Continue for approx. 3 miles through Emley and passing Emley Moor TV mast on the left. Turn right onto Jagger Lane and follow signs to Kirkburton after passing the mast. Follow the road (Turnshaw Road) downhill for 1.5 miles into Kirkburton. Turn right at the T-junction in the village onto North Road (B6116). Turn left into our car park after the pedestrian crossing.

From Huddersfield Town Centre

Leave the Huddersfield Ring Road on the A629, towards Wakefield. Continue for approx. 2 miles to Waterloo. Take the right fork at the traffic lights, continuing on the A629 towards Sheffield (Penistone Road). Continue on the A629 for approx. 2.5 miles. Turn left into North Road, signed Kirkburton (B6125). Continue into the village of Kirkburton. Turn right into the car park which is 10 yards before the pedestrian crossing.
